

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#### **Prof. Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed**

Chairman, Higher Education Commission (HEC)

Prof. Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed has assumed the charge of Chairman, Higher Education Commission (HEC) in 2022. He has previously served as Chairman HEC from 2014 to 2018, Executive Director HEC from 2013 to 2014 and as Member (Operations and Planning) HEC from 2005 to 2011. Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed has played a key role during the last two decades to formulate and implement reforms in the higher education, be it increase in the access to university education, strengthening quality assurance systems, convincing federal and provincial governments to raise funding for higher education, development of universities' infrastructure, promoting national and international collaborations of faculty, researchers and universities, steps to stop and discourage illegal

practices in the higher education sector, and a number of other initiatives.

Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed has also served as Deputy Director General, Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO) based in Rabat, Morocco, where he was responsible for Directorates of Education, Science, Culture and Communication, ICPSR, CPID (Planning and Strategic Division) and ISESCO Regional Centres. With a Bachelors and Masters of Science from University of Agriculture, Faisalabad and Masters in Business Administration and PhD from University of California, Riverside, USA, Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed has over three decades of educational development and management experience at national and international level that includes teaching, research, administration, policy development, linking educational research to industry / commercialization, introducing entrepreneurial approaches to education and a diverse range of educational development programmes. His distinguished career is enriched with diverse academic, research and administrative experience both in public and private sectors of higher education in Pakistan and abroad.

#### **Dr. Naukhez Sarwar**

Chairman, National Business Education Accreditation Council (NBEAC)

Dr. Naukhez Sarwar is the Principal and Dean of NUST Business School, National University of Sciences & Technology (NUST). He is also the Chairman of National Business Education Accreditation Council (NBEAC) of Pakistan and a Member of the Association of Management Development Institutes of South Asia (AMDISA). He is also a member of the Board of Governors (BoG) of Virtual University, Pakistan.

Dr. Naukhez Sarwar holds a PhD in Business Administration from the University of Manchester, UK and is associated with the academia since the past 25 years. He is actively involved in research, training and

consultancies in his areas of expertise which include Human Resource Management and Leadership. He also participates as a subject expert in the Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan in National Curriculum Review Committee for Business and Management.

#### **Dr. Farooq-E-Azam Cheema**

Vice Chairman, National Business Education Accreditation Council

Dr. Farooq-E-Azam Cheema is a graduate of the University of Karachi and the University of Manchester, UK, with an education in Human Resource Management and Development. He serves as Provost of the Karachi School of Business & Leadership (KSBL). Earlier, he served as Dean for ten years at various institutions. He has vast industry experience as an HR consultant. Besides, Dr. Cheema has had a rich association with the HEC and the NBEAC. He has been a member and secretary of the National Curriculum Review Committee of Business Administration Education since 2012 and has served on numerous committees. For the NBEAC, he reviewed 16 business schools as a lead reviewer and mentored 15 business schools. Among other services to the NBEAC, he authored its both strategic plans and prepared HR, Finance, and Admin manuals and the mentoring policy.
